



FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Tuition and Fees

Tuition is set by the Board of Directors each spring for the following school year. Normally tuition and fees increase approximately 6% annually. Books, field trips, yearbooks and various other ancillary fees are not included in the tuition. Participation in academic and athletic competition teams normally involve fees beyond those noted below. Information for the 2010-2011 school year is as follows:

** In addition to the registration fee, families new to the school are required to pay a non-refundable tuition deposit of \$750 at the time of registration which is applied to the first tuition payment due.*

Tuition Payment Plans

There are three tuition payment plans available. You are given the option to pay 1) one payment July 1 with a \$160 discount applied if received by the due date (no grace period); 2) two installments, one July 1 and one January 3 or 3) 11 monthly payments via electronic funds transfer from a bank account with an added \$220 payment plan fee (May 20 - March 20 or June 5 - April 5).

Additionally, the school offers an optional tuition refund plan which provides for refunds or cancellation of 60% of unused tuition for voluntary withdrawals or 100% for involuntary and medical withdrawals when certain conditions are met. Volunteerism and Donations

Our annual tuition and related fees do not cover the entire cost associated with the education of a Chaminade student. In order to supplement the cost of this education, Chaminade promotes various fundraising activities such as the Annual Fund Campaign, the Invitational Golf Tournament, and the Spring Gala. The School also fosters a family spirit through numerous programs and opportunities for volunteer service that is orchestrated through the Office of Advancement. Parents are invited and encouraged to take part in a variety of areas as their interests, talents and time permit.

Financial Assistance

Through the support of donors and volunteers, Chaminade is able to maintain a quality program at an affordable cost, while maintaining accessibility with the help of donations to our tuition assistance programs. Chaminade offers a tuition assistance program that is designed to aid families that might not otherwise afford a Chaminade education, as well as families that are experiencing temporary financial difficulties. During the 2009-2010 year, we have granted tuition assistance of approximately \$2,100,000 to more than 350 families. **The deadline to apply for tuition assistance is January 15, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school year.** If you wish to apply after this date, please contact Ms. Anderson (number below).
