ACADEMICS

As a reminder, the last day of instruction for students was Friday, May 19th. Students and parents at this time should check for the accuracy of their grades and make any inquiries before grade books go “dark” for students at 8:00am on the first day of final exams on Monday, May 22nd. Please make sure to use this weekend to communicate with teachers as needed before exams. Other than the final exam, no additional work can be accepted, graded, or entered into the grade books after May 19th without the direction of the administration or counseling office.

Information regarding senior finals:

- Seniors **HAVE TO TAKE EXAMS** unless they have a class average of a 92% (not a 91.5%) or above in the class.
- If a senior is going to fail a class, the failing grade will be reported to administration, and communicated to the student no later than THURSDAY May 25th. If a senior fail is not reported by the deadline, the lowest grade that can be applied for that senior course is a “D”.

A note about “mixed” senior classes:

- If you have a class that is “mixed” with seniors and underclassmen, ALL underclassmen must take their exam in every class, regardless of their class average. The “92% Rule” only applies to graduating seniors.
