Dear Chaminade Parents,

Three years ago we began our International Program, and it has been a wonderful addition to the Chaminade experience. A part of our program includes homestay for our students from China, and we invite our current families first to apply for the opportunity.

The homestay portion of the program is conducted in partnership with a firm called Twinn Palms. For the 2016-2017 school year, we anticipate having 20 Chinese students in Grades 6 to 12 who will need homestay families for next year.

While we have had many families host for the last few years, some families will no longer be able to continue in this role. We need a few more families to ensure that all of our Chinese students are well accommodated for next year. Host families will receive \$1,300 per month for each month that you host a student. In return, you provide meals, transportation to and from school and events, a private bedroom for each student, and wireless internet connection for the Tablet PC program. In addition, host families will be required to complete a safe environment training program and a background screening. All school lunches, uniforms and other campus expenses are covered through the tuition paid by the family in China.
